

2019 TUESDAY MEN'S LEAGUE SCHEDULE

APRIL

16TH – 2 PERSON SCRAMBLE

23RD – 2 PERSON SHAMBLE

(Both Players Tee Off and Select the Best Shot Then Play Your own ball for the Lowest Score.)

30TH – 4 PERSON VEGAS SCRAMBLE

(Each players of the four man team is allocated a number, 1 to 4, and after all players have tee off A Dice is rolled to determine which Drive to Use. If 5, Best Drive, 6 worst Drive. Scramble the rest till ball is holed)

MAY

7TH – 2 PERSON BEST BALL

14TH – 2 PERSON GOLDEN SCRAMBLE

(All Players Scramble from the Gold Tees)

21ST – 2 PERSON SHAMBLE

28TH – 2 PERSON LADDER SCRAMBLE

(Regular scramble starting from the White Tees. If team birdies/Eagles, You Move Back a Tee Box on Next Hole. If Bogey, You Move up a Tee Box on Next Hole.)

JUNE

4TH – 2 PERSON BEST BALL VS. THE PRO'S

(Shamble off tee then play your own ball counting 1 score VS. The Pro's Double points if your score is lower)

11TH – 4 PERSON SHAMBLE

(Select the best drive and then all players play their own ball from that position counting 2 Scores using Dice.)

18TH – 2 PERSON SCRAMBLE

25TH – 4 PERSON CHA-CHA-CHA

(Players Tee Off and Select the Best Shot Then Play Your own ball using 1 low score on par 3's, 2 on the par 4's and 3 on the par 5's)

JULY

9TH – 2 PERSON BEST BALL

16TH – 4 PERSON VEGAS SCRAMBLE

23RD – 2 PERSON SHAMBLE

30TH – 2 PERSON GOLDEN SCRAMBLE

AUGUST

6TH – 2 PERSON SCRAMBLE

13TH – 4 PERSON ROUND ROBIN

(Each Player will Scramble with 3 different partners counting both teams score. Ex. Players 1 & 2 – 3 & 4 for 3 Holes...etc.)

20TH – JOKER'S WILD SHAMBLE

(Each team member is designated by a different playing suit (heart, diamond, spade, club) Once on the green, golfers find a playing card in the bottom of the cup. The suit of that card determines which team member's score counts on that hole.)

27TH – 2 PERSON BEST BALL VS. THE PRO'S

SEPTEMBER

3RD – 2 PERSON SHAMBLE

10TH – 2 PERSON LADDER SCRAMBLE

17TH – 2 PERSON BEST BALL

24TH – 2 PERSON SCRAMBLE

OCTOBER

5TH – SEASON ENDING TOURNAMENT
